



## NEW REVOLUTION IN STANDARDS ACCESS

**The cost of accessing ISO standards can be unaffordable and time consuming, particularly for small/medium companies operating in the marine industry**

With this in mind, ICOMIA began working with industry colleagues Wieger de Wit and Marnix Hoekstra, innovative developers of **www.rulefinder.net**, to provide more affordable and convenient access to their renowned 'standards library'.

Rulefinder is a database providing boat builders, component manufacturers and other industry professionals with an online, single-source library of global marine-related ISO standards.

Previously users could only subscribe for annual membership to the database, however after consultation with ICOMIA, Rulefinder's developers have launched a monthly subscription package - ideal for companies on a budget, or those simply not requiring all-year-round access.

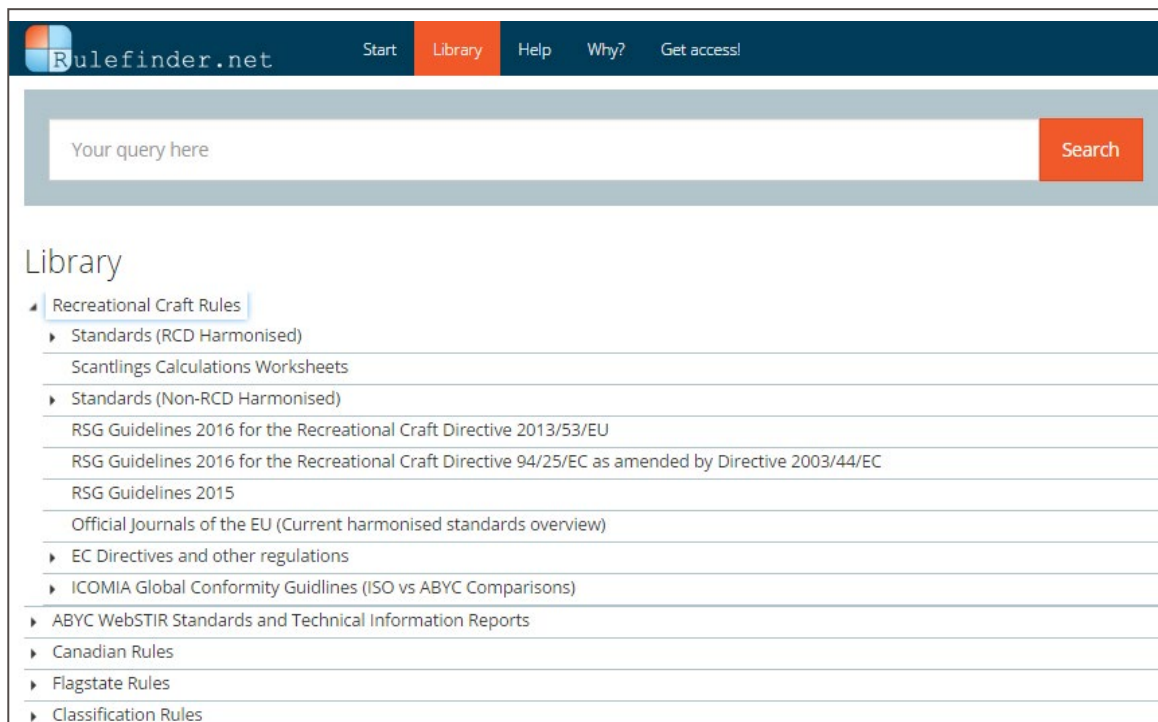
## MORE ABOUT RULEFINDER
